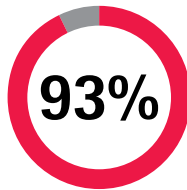

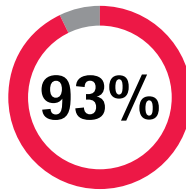

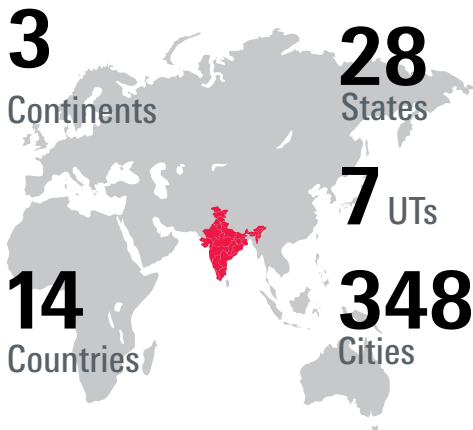

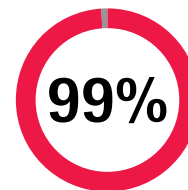
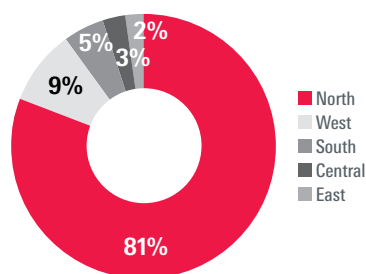


Exhibitors were satisfied with overall visitor profile

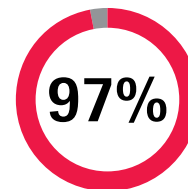

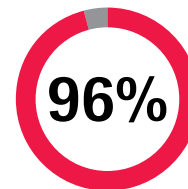
Region-wise segregation and summary



Visitors likely to recommend a visit to LED Expo to business friends or colleagues

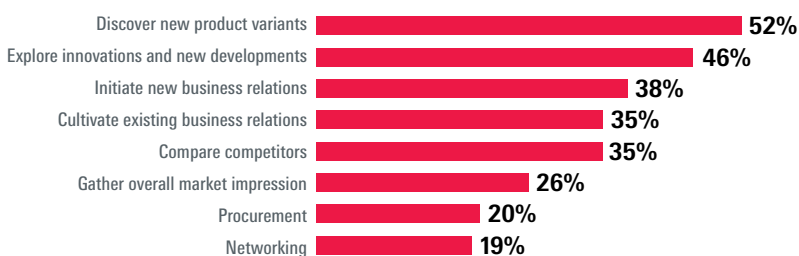


Visitors were satisfied overall with their visit to LED Expo New Delhi 2023
